Volunteers may be called upon a few times during the year to prepare a meal for a family that is grieving, welcoming a new baby, dealing with a medical crisis, etc. The preparer brings the complete meal to the STA office in the morning, and it is sent home with the receiving family in the afternoon. Typically, the receiving family remains anonymous. The need for meals is unpredictable, dependent as it is on the circumstances of our families. Certainly, the more volunteers we have, the lighter the job will be for everyone involved.
